The Veterans and Military Families Caucus supports your legislation HJR 1 & SJR 3 - Session Length, Subjects and Overrides, CA

Changing legislative sessions to 45 days in length for each year of a biennium, removing the subject restrictions on even-numbered years and allowing for overrides of governor vetoes in the second year of the biennium for vetoes issued in previous sessions will **make our state legislature more efficient and effective.**

It is time for a change that would allow our legislators more flexibility and frankly get more done with the precious amount of time they are in session.
